Covid Updates

Currently Mrs Truter and Miss Wilson are isolating due to Covid. Both cases were contracted outside of school as far as we can ascertain.

Thankfully they are both dealing with mild symptoms at this stage.

I would ask that you continue to monitor your child/children for any symptoms, keep them home if they are unwell, getting them tests if need be, and informing us promptly so we act to minimise transmission.

All students should now have two textbooks which are to be carried to and from school daily.

These are to be kept in their school bag in the event they have to isolate at home. This is their school work.

The first is a Dragon Maths text book, the second is a Start Right homework book. **Please disregard any Year level labelling on the titles.** These books have been allocated based upon your child's levels of learning as indicated by our recent standardised assessments.

In the event that they are needed, we envisage that your child would complete 1 unit of work from the homework book daily, with an additional 45 minutes of maths work from the Dragon Maths books to supplement this. **The children do write in these books. They are now their property.**

The answers are in the backs of both books to assist you when marking work at home.
